### A RESOLUTION

1 Commending and congratulating Jordan Schwartz; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Jordan Schwartz, an esteemed resident of Marietta, Georgia, and a student at  
3 Atlanta Girls' School, has achieved national recognition for exemplary volunteer service in  
4 being selected for a 2005 Prudential Spirit of Community Award; and

5 WHEREAS, this prestigious award, presented by Prudential Financial in partnership with the  
6 National Association of Secondary School Principals, honors young volunteers nationwide  
7 who have demonstrated an extraordinary commitment to serving their communities; and

8 WHEREAS, Ms. Schwartz earned her award by giving generously of her time and energy  
9 to founding a children's bilingual theater group that presented eight performances of a play  
10 in Spanish and English; and

11 WHEREAS, her leadership was vital in planning the production and budget, raising funds,  
12 recruiting cast members from local schools, building sets, and overseeing rehearsals; and

13 WHEREAS, the Prudential Spirit of Community Awards are America's largest youth  
14 recognition program based exclusively on volunteer community service, and more than  
15 20,000 young people across the country were considered for recognition this year; and

16 WHEREAS, the success of the State of Georgia, the strength of our communities, and the  
17 vitality of American society in general depend, in great measure, upon the dedication of  
18 young people like Jordan Schwartz, who use their considerable talents and resources to serve  
19 others.

21 commend and congratulate Jordan Schwartz, winner of the Prudential Spirit of Community
