A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Jack Baggett Jackson for rendering lifesaving assistance to the victim of a car
2 accident; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, while driving on Mundy Mill Road on Monday, August 16, 2004, Jack Baggett
4 Jackson observed a car suddenly swerve off the road and plunge down a steep hill, leaving
5 no sign of its perilous track; and

6 WHEREAS, stopping to render assistance, the Boy Scout made his way down the hill and
7 observed that the driver, Linda Shook, was suffering from a severe injury; and

8 WHEREAS, remembering the first aid training he had received from his Scout leaders, Mr.
9 Jackson instructed another motorist to call 911 and kept Ms. Shook calm and awake while
10 waiting for emergency personnel to arrive; and

11 WHEREAS, Mr. Jackson's ability to maintain his composure and bravely deliver first aid to
12 this accident victim reflects a strength of character and maturity beyond his years; and

13 WHEREAS, his actions serve as an example to all citizens of the importance of first aid
14 training and remind us that each trained individual can make a lifesaving difference in a
15 medical emergency.

16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
17 the members of this body join in commending the courageous and lifesaving actions of Jack
18 Baggett Jackson and extend their sincere best wishes to this exemplary young man.

19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
20 and directed to transmit an appropriate copy of this resolution to Jack Baggett Jackson.
