## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Commending the 2004 Lowndes High School football team and inviting them to appear  
2 before the House of Representatives; and for other purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, the 2004 Lowndes High School football team has undertaken the challenge to  
4 strengthen their bodies, minds, and spirits and to build character within themselves through  
5 competition; and
- 6 WHEREAS, these are some of the pathways of becoming bright, well-rounded, productive  
7 students and adults; and
- 8 WHEREAS, the 2004 Lowndes High School football team has played with skill, excellence,  
9 and courage, ultimately achieving the status of greatness; and
- 10 WHEREAS, the team members have distinguished themselves for their teamwork,  
11 leadership, pride, sportsmanship, and exceptional ability; and
- 12 WHEREAS, the team scored 560 points during the season for an average of 37.3 points per  
13 game with a margin of victory of 30.6 points per game; and
- 14 WHEREAS, the 2004 Lowndes High School football team had six shutouts and only allowed  
15 an average of 6.6 points per game; and
- 16 WHEREAS, the team never trailed in a game throughout the entire season; and
- 17 WHEREAS, the team excelled and completed a grueling season with a 15-0 record,  
18 culminating with the Class AAAAA state championship on Saturday, December 4, 2004, at  
19 Parkview High School, Stone Mountain, Georgia; and

1 WHEREAS, the Lowndes County School System and Lowndes County community  
2 appreciate and acknowledge the extreme dedication of Coach Randy McPherson, all assistant  
3 coaches, players, support personnel, cheerleaders, band, and any and all others who assisted  
4 or encouraged this team in any way.

6 the members of this body commend the members and coaches of the 2004 Lowndes High  
7 School football team for their achievements and invite them to appear before the House of
