A RESOLUTION

- 1 Commending Cliff Yearta on becoming an Eagle Scout; and for other purposes.

- 3 WHEREAS, Cliff Yearta, a member of Boy Scout Troop 100, has earned the rank of Eagle
4 Scout; and
- 5 WHEREAS, since 1911, the Eagle Scout Award has been the symbol of the highest and most
6 prestigious achievement among the Boy Scouts of America; and
- 7 WHEREAS, the attainment of Eagle Scout rank indicates that a Scout has developed
8 leadership ability, self-confidence, mature judgment, and mental and physical capabilities
9 that will be of immense benefit throughout life; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Cliff Yearta has amply demonstrated to his Scout leaders and peers that he
11 possesses these qualities along with sterling character; and
- 12 WHEREAS, for a Scout to reach Eagle rank, he must earn 21 merit badges, 12 of which are
13 mandatory requirements for the Eagle Scout program; and
- 14 WHEREAS, in achieving Eagle Scout status, Cliff Yearta has brought honor not only to
15 himself but also to his family and troop.
- 16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
17 recognize and commend Cliff Yearta for his diligence and dedication in pursuing the highest
18 honor awarded by the Boy Scouts of America and congratulate him on attaining the
