A RESOLUTION

- 1 Commending Adam William Greim on becoming an Eagle Scout; and for other purposes.

- 3 WHEREAS, Adam William Greim has earned the rank of Eagle Scout, to be awarded during
4 a ceremony in April, 2005; and
- 5 WHEREAS, since 1911, the Eagle Scout Award has been the symbol of the highest and most
6 prestigious achievement among the Boy Scouts of America; and
- 7 WHEREAS, the attainment of Eagle Scout rank indicates that a Scout has developed
8 leadership ability, self-confidence, mature judgment, and mental and physical capabilities
9 that will be of immense benefit throughout life; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Adam William Greim has amply demonstrated to his Scout leaders and peers
11 that he possesses these qualities along with sterling character; and
- 12 WHEREAS, for a Scout to reach Eagle rank, he must earn 21 merit badges, 12 of which are
13 mandatory requirements for the Eagle Scout program; and
- 14 WHEREAS, in achieving Eagle Scout status, Adam William Greim has brought honor not
15 only to himself but also to his family and Troop 629.
- 16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
17 recognize and commend Adam William Greim for his diligence and dedication in pursuing
18 the highest honor awarded by the Boy Scouts of America and congratulate him on attaining
