

## House Resolution 365

## A RESOLUTION

1 Proposing an amendment to the Constitution so as to provide for the creation of a school  
 2 health and physical education support fund and program; to provide funds for the program  
 3 from the voluntary purchase of special license plates and other sources; to provide for related  
 4 matters; to provide for submission of this amendment for ratification or rejection; and for  
 5 other purposes.

6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 **SECTION 1.**

8 Article III, Section IX, Paragraph VI of the Constitution is amended by adding at the end  
 9 thereof a new subparagraph (n) to read as follows:

10 "(n) The General Assembly is authorized to provide by general law for the creation of a  
 11 school health and physical education support fund, from which funds shall be disbursed for  
 12 the implementation, operation, and support of a school health and physical education  
 13 program. The General Assembly shall provide by law for the issuance beginning in 2007  
 14 of specially designed license plates promoting the program and for dedication of certain  
 15 revenue derived from fees for such plates to the support of the fund. All such dedicated  
 16 revenue derived from special license plate fees, any funds appropriated for such purposes,  
 17 and any voluntary contributions or other funds made available for such purposes and all  
 18 interest thereon shall be deposited in the fund for support of the program, shall not be used  
 19 for any purpose other than support of the program, and shall not lapse. The General  
 20 Assembly may provide by law for all matters necessary for or appropriate to the  
 21 implementation of this paragraph."

22 **SECTION 2.**

23 The above proposed amendment to the Constitution shall be published and submitted as  
 24 provided in Article X, Section I, Paragraph II of the Constitution. The ballot submitting the  
 25 above proposed amendment shall have written or printed thereon the following:

1     " YES    Shall the Constitution of Georgia be amended so as to provide for the creation  
2                    of a school health and physical education support fund for the implementation,  
3      NO    operation, and support of a school health and physical education program and  
4                    to provide funds for the program from the voluntary purchase of special  
5                    license plates and other sources?"

6   All persons desiring to vote in favor of ratifying the proposed amendment shall vote "Yes."  
7   All persons desiring to vote against ratifying the proposed amendment shall vote "No." If  
8   such amendment shall be ratified as provided in said Paragraph of the Constitution, it shall  
9   become a part of the Constitution of this state.
