A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing the Coalition of Labor Union Women and inviting the Georgia Chapter of the
2 Coalition of Labor Union Women to appear before the House of Representatives; and for
3 other purposes.
- 4 WHEREAS, the Coalition of Labor Union Women (CLUW) is America's only national
5 organization for union women; and
- 6 WHEREAS, formed in 1974, CLUW is a nonpartisan organization within the union
7 movement; and
- 8 WHEREAS, the primary mission of CLUW is to unify all union women in a viable
9 organization to determine their common problems and to develop action programs to deal
10 effectively with their objectives; and
- 11 WHEREAS, with members from 60 international and national unions across the United
12 States and Canada, CLUW has a strong network of more than 75 chapters; and
- 13 WHEREAS, CLUW members actively speak out on issues relating to equal pay, child and
14 elder care benefits, job security, safe workplaces, affordable health care, contraceptive
15 equality, and protection from sexual harassment and violence at work.
- 16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
17 the members of this body recognize and commend the Coalition of Labor Union Women and
18 invite the members of the Georgia Chapter to appear before this body at a date and time to
19 be determined by the Speaker.
- 20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
21 and directed to transmit an appropriate copy of this resolution to the Georgia Chapter of the
22 Coalition of Labor Union Women.
