A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend Chapter 19 of Title 50 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to state
2 travel services, so as to change the rate of mileage reimbursement to state officers and
3 employees traveling on state business in their personal motor vehicles; to repeal conflicting
4 laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 style="text-align:center">**SECTION 1.**

7 Chapter 19 of Title 50 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to state travel
8 services, is amended by striking Code Section 50-19-7, relating to mileage and actual travel
9 expenses for state officials and employees, and inserting in its place a new Code section to
10 read as follows:

11 "50-19-7.

12 The officers, officials, and employees of the executive, legislative, and judicial branches
13 of state government shall be ~~paid 28¢ per mile~~ reimbursed for mileage at the same mileage
14 rate as allowed by the federal government as of January 1, 2005, as traveling expense when
15 traveling in the service of the state or any agency thereof by personal motor vehicle and,
16 in addition to mileage, shall be reimbursed for actual expenses incurred by reason of tolls
17 and parking fees."

19 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
