A RESOLUTION

1 Congratulating Mr. J. Skylar Martin on his selection as International President of Sertoma
2 Clubs; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the core of Sertoma Clubs is "SERvice TOMAnkind," and their primary service
4 project is assisting the more than 50 million people with speech, hearing, and language
5 disorders; and

6 WHEREAS, Mr. J. Skylar Martin has been a member of the Albany, Georgia, Sertoma Club
7 since 1986 and served as its president in 1990 to 1991 and as the distinguished governor for
8 the West Georgia District from 1996 to 1998; and

9 WHEREAS, he also served as director for Sertoma International from 1998 to 2000 and as
10 its vice president from 2000 to 2002, and his outstanding leadership and dedication have
11 been recognized by his selection as Sertoman of the Year by the Albany Sertoma Club in
12 1992 and as the Billy Haley Sertoman of the Year in 1993; and

13 WHEREAS, Mr. Martin has received the distinct honor of being chosen as President of
14 Sertoma International; and

15 WHEREAS, in this position, Mr. Martin serves over 20,000 members in nearly 700 clubs
16 across Canada, Mexico, Puerto Rico, and the United States; and

17 WHEREAS, the successful businessman gives generously of his time as a volunteer with
18 organizations and efforts such as the American Cancer Society, the YMCA Sustaining
19 Member Drive, the United Way Campaign, the Albany Arts Council, and the American Heart
20 Association; and

21 WHEREAS, it is highly fitting and proper that this body recognize Mr. Martin's laudable
22 efforts and achievements in service to his fellow citizens.

1 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
2 join in congratulating Mr. J. Skylar Martin on the distinction of being selected as
3 International President of Sertoma Clubs and extend their sincere best wishes for a highly
