1 Senator Adelman of the 42nd offered the following amendment to the Senate Science and
2 Technology Committee substitute to SB 62 (LC 29 1687S):

3 By inserting after "admissibility into evidence;" on line 11 of page 1 the following:

4 "to provide for interjurisdictional cooperation in certain investigations; to provide for civil
5 and criminal immunity for certain businesses under certain circumstances;".

6 By striking the quotation marks at the end of line 20 and inserting between lines 20 and 21
7 of page 12 the following:

8 "16-9-110.

9 Any law enforcement unit or prosecutorial office of the State of Georgia is hereby
10 authorized to apply to the court or other appropriate entity of the United States or any other
11 state with jurisdiction over a respondent for the issuance of search warrants, subpoenas, or
12 orders to produce as may be appropriate to further a pending criminal investigation or
13 prosecution of a pending criminal trial of a crime enumerated in Code Section 16-9-108.

14 16-9-111.

15 Any business located within the State of Georgia that provides electronic communication
16 services or remote computing services, when served with a search warrant, subpoena,
17 notice to produce, notice of deposition, or order to disclose properly issued by another state
18 to produce records related to investigation or trial of a criminal offense that would reveal
19 the identity of the customers using those services, data stored by, or on behalf of, the
20 customer, the customer's usage of those services, the recipient or destination of
21 communications sent to or from those customers, or the content of those communications
22 shall produce those requested records as if that search warrant, subpoena, notice, or order
23 had been issued by a Georgia court, provided that such business has the right to object that
24 such compliance is unduly burdensome or oppressive.

26 No civil or criminal cause of action shall lie against any foreign or Georgia business or its
27 officers, employees, agents, or other persons for providing records, information, facilities,
28 or assistance pursuant to Code Section 16-9-109 or 16-9-111."
