AS PASSED SENATE

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Article 1 of Chapter 2 of Title 40 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 2 relating to registration and licensing of motor vehicles generally, so as to prohibit the use of
- 3 plastic, other types of material, or body parts covering license plates; to provide for related
- 4 matters; to provide an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Article 1 of Chapter 2 of Title 40 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 8 registration and licensing of motor vehicles, is amended by inserting immediately following
- 9 Code Section 40-2-6 a new Code Section 40-2-6.1 to read as follows:
- 10 "40-2-6.1.
- Any person who willfully covers any license plate with plastic, other material, or any part
- of his or her body in order to prevent or impede the ability of surveillance equipment to
- clearly photograph or otherwise obtain a clear image of the license plate is guilty of a
- misdemeanor and shall be punished by a fine not to exceed \$1,000.00."

15 SECTION 2.

16 This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2005.

SECTION 3.

18 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
