

Senate Resolution 363

A RESOLUTION

1 Welcoming Consul General Yeshun Hu to the Georgia General Assembly; and for other
2 purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Consul General Yeshun Hu is responsible for a consular jurisdiction of eight
4 southern states, including Georgia; and

5 WHEREAS, the Consul General represents the People's Republic of China and serves
6 Chinese citizens within this consular jurisdiction; and

7 WHEREAS, the Consul General is committed to exchange and cooperation between China
8 and the southeastern United States on matters of trade, economy, science, technology, and
9 culture; and

10 WHEREAS, the People's Republic of China is a growing partner in the world's economy; and

11 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia has an interest in pursuing economic, cultural, and
12 educational partnerships with the People's Republic of China; and

13 WHEREAS, members of the Georgia General Assembly have formed the China Caucus to
14 explore the possibilities for future growth and relationships between Georgia and China; and

15 WHEREAS, Mr. Yeshun Hu has had a dignified career of service in the Ministry of Foreign
16 Affairs, including serving at the Embassy of the People's Republic of China in the Togolese
17 Republic and the Embassy of the People's Republic of China in Mexico, serving as consul
18 at the Consulate General of the People's Republic of China in San Francisco, serving at the
19 Embassy of the People's Republic of China in Canada, and, finally, serving as the Consul
20 General of the People's Republic of China in Houston.

1 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that this body welcomes
2 Consul General Yeshun Hu to the Georgia General Assembly.

3 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed
4 to transmit an appropriate copy of this resolution to Consul General Yeshun Hu.
