

ADOPTED

1 Senators Adelman of the 42nd, Kemp of the 46th and Rogers of the 21st offered the
2 following amendment:

3 Amend the Senate Public Safety and Homeland Security Committee substitute to SB 168:

4 By adding the following after "motorsports;" on line 4 on page 1.

5 "to provide for special license plates to promote 'Share the Road' messages for motorists
6 and bicyclists and to benefit programs related to such motorists and bicyclists;"

7 By adding the following between lines 17 and 18 on page 1.

8 "Also, in order to promote and provide for motorist and bicyclist safety and interaction
9 education and awareness programs and media campaigns; adult and child bicycling safety
10 training, workshops, and educational materials; assistance in forming local bicycle advisory
11 committees; law enforcement education and implementation programs for policing by
12 bicycle and policing to improve bicycling conditions; and 'share the road/yield to
13 bicycles/bicyclists may use full lane' sign installations through the Governor's Highway
14 Safety Program, there shall be issued beginning January 1, 2006, special license plates
15 promoting and benefitting such efforts, which shall be known as the 'Share the Road'
16 Motorists and Bicyclists special license plate."

17 By adding the following in place of "The" at the beginning of line 18 on page 1.

18 "For the NASCAR plates, the"

19 By adding the following after "theme." on line 20 on page 1.

20 "For the 'Share the Road' plates, the commissioner shall design a special distinctive license
21 plate in conjunction with the Southern Bicycle League and Bicycle Ride Across Georgia
22 appropriate to promote the message of motorists and bicyclists safely and courteously
23 sharing the roadway."

24 By adding the following after "Program." on line 24 on page 2.

25 "Subject to the general appropriations process, it is the intent of the General Assembly that
26 funds derived from the sale of 'Share the Road' license plates shall be utilized by the
27 Governor's Highway Safety Program to provide for motorist and bicyclist safety and
28 interaction education and awareness programs and media campaigns; adult and child
29 bicycling safety training, workshops, and educational materials; assistance in forming local

1 bicycle advisory committees; law enforcement education and implementation programs for
2 policing by bicycle and policing to improve bicycling conditions; and 'share the road/yield
3 to bicycles/bicyclists may use full lane' sign installations. The Office of Highway Safety
4 may enter into contractual agreements, as may be appropriate, to further such objectives.
5 The Office of Highway Safety may provide said funds for use as local or minimum
6 matching funds."
