ADOPTED SENATE

A RESOLUTION

- 1 Creating the Senate Study Committee on Public-private Infrastructure Projects; and for other
- 2 purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, other states have in recent years enacted legislation authorizing and regulating
- 4 public-private infrastructure projects and have experienced success in making available
- 5 additional education, transportation, environmental, and public facilities to the general public
- 6 while minimizing the need for additional public tax revenues; and
- 7 WHEREAS, public-private partnerships may provide the opportunity to make such facilities
- 8 available at a lower overall cost for the life-cycle of the facilities; and
- 9 WHEREAS, public-private partnerships may make available professional and experienced
- 10 project management services which can facilitate and accelerate completion of projects; and
- WHEREAS, a study of other states' experience and the possible benefits of legislation to
- 12 authorize and regulate public-private infrastructure projects will assist this body's future
- 13 consideration of such issues.
- 14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that there is created the Senate
- 15 Study Committee on Public-private Infrastructure Projects to be composed of five members
- of the Senate to be appointed by the Senate Committee on Assignments. The Senate
- 17 Committee on Assignments shall designate a member of the committee as chairperson of the
- 18 committee. The chairperson shall call all meetings of the committee.
- 19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the committee shall undertake a study of the issues
- 20 discussed above and other related matters and recommend any action or legislation which
- 21 the committee deems necessary or appropriate. The committee may conduct such meetings
- 22 at such places and at such times as it may deem necessary or convenient to enable it to
- 23 exercise fully and effectively its powers, perform its duties, and accomplish the objectives

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1 and purposes of this resolution. The members of the committee shall receive the allowances

2 provided for in Code Section 28-1-8 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated. The

3 allowances authorized by this resolution shall not be received by any member of the

4 committee for more than five days unless additional days are authorized. The funds necessary

5 to carry out the provisions of this resolution shall come from the funds appropriated to the

6 Senate. In the event the committee makes a report of its findings and recommendations, with

suggestions for proposed legislation, if any, such report shall be made on or before

8 December 31, 2005. The committee shall stand abolished on December 31, 2005.

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
