## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Commending Dawn A. Randolph for her service to her community; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, after completing an International Political Science degree at Pennsylvania State  
3 University, Dawn A. Randolph joined the Atlanta staff of Senator Sam Nunn and, during her  
4 five years as a congressional aide, was responsible for constituent services,  
5 intergovernmental affairs, and special projects; and
- 6 WHEREAS, while completing her Master of Public Administration degree at Georgia State  
7 University, she served in state government at the Georgia Department of Community Affairs,  
8 providing consulting services to city and county officials on management and budget; and
- 9 WHEREAS, she was the Public Policy Director for the Atlanta Alliance on Development  
10 Disabilities and was appointed by Governor Barnes to his Blue Ribbon Task Force on  
11 Community Based Services, where she served as the principal researcher and author of the  
12 committee's final report; and
- 13 WHEREAS, in 2002, the recommendations of this task force secured \$22 million in new  
14 funding to support people with disabilities and seniors; and
- 15 WHEREAS, the consulting firm she founded in 2002 assists organizations such as AARP  
16 Georgia, Easter Seals, Georgia Council on Substance Abuse, GATES, and Georgia  
17 Community Support and Solutions as well as grassroots political action projects with their  
18 advocacy efforts; and
- 19 WHEREAS, Mrs. Randolph gives generously of her time and talent to volunteer  
20 organizations within her community and is an outstanding supporter of young women  
21 leaders.

1 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
2 the members of this body join in commending Dawn A. Randolph for her extensive and  
3 effective work on behalf of the citizens of her community.
