A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 47-2-98 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 creditable service for a member of the Employees' Retirement System of Georgia who was
- 3 an officer or employee of the Georgia Housing and Finance Authority, so as to authorize the
- 4 member seeking creditable service to make payment to the board of trustees of such
- 5 retirement system; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 Code Section 47-2-98 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to creditable
- 9 service for a member of the Employees' Retirement System of Georgia who was an officer
- 10 or employee of the Georgia Housing and Finance Authority, is amended by striking in its
- entirety paragraph (2) of subsection (b) and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
- 12 "(2) A member subject to this Code section shall have the option to transfer all or a
- portion of his or her vested interest in the pension plan maintained by the authority prior
- 14 to the date he or she became a member of this retirement system to satisfy all or a portion
- of the cost to receive creditable service allowed pursuant to paragraph (1) of this
- subsection. Any funds transferred pursuant to such option shall be credited to the officer's
- member shall be authorized, but not required, to supplement such amount so transferred.

- The member shall receive such creditable service as the combination of funds so
- transferred or paid would warrant without creating any additional accrued liability of the
