A RESOLUTION

1 Commending University System of Georgia Outstanding Scholar Danielle Pauline Burns of
2 Valdosta State University on Academic Recognition Day for 2005; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Georgia's educational system is dedicated to the goal of providing a quality
4 education to all and fostering the realization of each person's fullest potential; and

5 WHEREAS, the 34 institutions of the University System of Georgia are valuable resources
6 for the people of this state, enhancing the intellectual, economic, social, civic, and cultural
