## A RESOLUTION

1 Commending University System of Georgia Outstanding Scholar Justin Thomas Ford of  
2 Georgia Institute of Technology on Academic Recognition Day for 2005; and for other  
3 purposes.

4 WHEREAS, Georgia's educational system is dedicated to the goal of providing a quality  
5 education to all and fostering the realization of each person's fullest potential; and

6 WHEREAS, the 34 institutions of the University System of Georgia are valuable resources  
7 for the people of this state, enhancing the intellectual, economic, social, civic, and cultural  
8 well-being of the communities in which they are located and the entire state; and

9 WHEREAS, Academic Recognition Day was begun in 1987 as a celebration of individual  
10 academic achievement and recognition of those students who exemplify that which is best  
11 about the University System of Georgia and its institutions: inspired and dedicated teaching  
12 and excellence in learning; and

13 WHEREAS, Justin Thomas Ford, a scholar from Georgia Institute of Technology, represents  
14 excellence in academic achievement and personal development.

15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that University System of  
16 Georgia Outstanding Scholar Justin Thomas Ford is commended for superb achievements  
17 in education and selection as a representative of Georgia Institute of Technology on the  
18 occasion of Academic Recognition Day for 2005.
