A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing and commending Portal Middle and High School, winner of the 2004 Class A
2 Governor's Cup and inviting its students, parents, teachers, and administrators to appear
3 before the House of Representatives; and for other purposes.
- 4 WHEREAS, the Governor's Cup recognizes high schools demonstrating academic excellence
5 through their performance on the SAT, and winners are selected based on the improvement
6 of the senior class's average SAT score between the current and previous years; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Governor Sonny Perdue established the Governor's Cup to boost improvement
8 in SAT scores, highlight effective models and strategies for elevating student performance
9 on the SAT, and celebrate the success of high achieving schools; and
- 10 WHEREAS, the students of Portal Middle and High School have made a 97.5 point
11 improvement on their average SAT score from 2003; and
- 12 WHEREAS, in recognition of this exemplary performance, Portal Middle and High School
13 has been named the 2004 Class A Governor's Cup award winner, receiving a \$2,000 grant
14 and tickets to a home game of the Atlanta Braves; and
- 15 WHEREAS, their achievement stands as a shining example of the important impact that the
16 collaborative efforts of individual teachers and administrators along with bright and focused
17 students and their parents can make on the quality of education received by the children of
18 this state.
- 19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
20 the members of this body join in recognizing and commending the students, parents,
21 teachers, and administrators of Portal Middle and High School, winners of the 2004 Class
22 A Governor's Cup, and extend to them sincere best wishes for their continued success.
