

ADOPTED

1 Senators Johnson of the 1st and Tate of the 38th offered the following amendment:

2 Amend HB 282 by adding after the semicolon on line 4 of page 1 the following:

3 "to provide for exempt status of certain compensation payments from the State of Georgia;
4 to provide for related matters;"

5 By renumbering Sections 2 through 4 as Sections 3 through 5, respectively, and inserting a
6 new Section 2 to read as follows:

7 **"SECTION 2.**

8 Said article is further amended by adding after Code Section 48-7-26 a new Code Section
9 48-7-26.1 to read as follows:

10 '48-7-26.1.

11 Any income received by a person from the State of Georgia resulting from the General
12 Assembly's enactment of a compensation resolution compensating such person for
13 damages incurred because of his or her wrongful conviction of a crime shall be exempt
14 from income taxation by this state."
