- 1 Recognizing and commending Reverend J. Bernard Kent, Sr.; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, on August 18, 2004, Our Brother's Keeper in Savannah held an awards
3 ceremony to recognize and honor men and women who helped compile an unparalleled
4 legacy of more than 40 years of good works and service rendered to the community; and
- 5 WHEREAS, among the honorees was Reverend J. Bernard Kent, Sr., who was born in
6 Dover, Georgia, and who received the call to the ministry in 1939 at the age of 19; and
- 7 WHEREAS, he attended Bryant Theological Seminary and began his pastorate at Saint
8 Matthew Baptist Church in Millen, Georgia, and over the next 49 years he served the Lord
9 in numerous churches, ending his formal ministry in 1990 after serving for ten years as pastor
10 of Saint Matthew Baptist Church in Springfield, Georgia; and
- 11 WHEREAS, his many years of dedicated service in the Lord's name earned him the love of
12 not only his own flock but of citizens of all persuasions, who knew him to be a loving and
13 kind-hearted person always willing to go the extra mile with anyone who needed his help;

- 15 WHEREAS, he is married to Mrs. Luden Miller of Ogeechee, Georgia, and has three
16 children, Bernard, Jr., Elise, and Bettie.
