- 5 WHEREAS, Reverend Pryor was called and licensed to preach the Gospel by our Lord and
6 Saviour Jesus Christ on January 18, 1962, while serving the First Jerusalem Baptist Church

9 in the greater Savannah community, including Lapageville Baptist Church, Bolton Street
