A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing the founding of the Marietta Center for Advanced Academics in Math, Science,
2 and Technology; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the Marietta Center for Advanced Academics in Math, Science, and
4 Technology, which will house such cutting edge technology as three science labs for
5 environmental, engineering, and aerospace studies, a video production studio, a
6 telecommunications and presentation station, and a fully automated media center, is the first
7 Elementary Magnet School in Cobb County and will serve 360 students in grades three
8 through five who have demonstrated academic excellence; and

9 WHEREAS, Jeri Hatler will serve as the first principal of this exciting new school and will
10 lead a team of outstanding educators to accelerate student achievement in a unique and
11 challenging learning environment while fostering the creativity of their bright and promising
12 student body; and

13 WHEREAS, the magnet school, located in the remodeled Pine Street Elementary School
14 building, is a project of the Marietta Board of Education and will carry on a tradition of
15 excellence and innovation characteristic of Marietta City Schools; and

16 WHEREAS, this impressive facility will open its doors for the first time in August of 2005.

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
18 the members of this body join in recognizing the founding of the Marietta Center for
19 Advanced Academics in Math, Science, and Technology and extend their sincere best wishes
20 for the success of all its future students, teachers, and administrators.

21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
