12 the season with an amazing 10 game winning streak, crushing these opponents by an average
13 of 21 points, and a season record of 27-5, losing to only two Georgia teams; and

15 and determination that displayed a maturity beyond the years of this team of young men; and

16 WHEREAS, the Dunwoody community and the State of Georgia take great pride in not only
17 their victory on the court but also in the exemplary team spirit and sportsmanship of these
