A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring the memory of S. Dan Waller, Sr., and expressing regret at his passing; and for
2 other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, news of the passing of S. Dan Waller, Sr., is received with deep regret by this
4 body; and

5 WHEREAS, the life led by this distinguished gentleman of 90 years rendered his name dear
6 to the hearts of his family and fellow citizens alike; and

7 WHEREAS, a native of Treutlen County, he moved to Reidsville in 1938; and

8 WHEREAS, he spent most of his life in law enforcement; served as a county policeman; was
9 elected Tattnall County sheriff and served in that capacity from 1949 through 1956; and
10 served as a special investigator for the Georgia Department of Transportation for 22 years;

12 WHEREAS, he was a member and deacon of Reidsville Baptist Church, a 50-year Mason,
13 and a member of the Reidsville Lions Club for more than 55 years; and

14 WHEREAS, while in life he commanded the esteem of his fellow citizens, in his death we
15 mingle our sympathies with the grief of his family and friends.

16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
17 honor the memory of S. Dan Waller, Sr., and express their regret at his passing.
