

## Senate Resolution 532

## A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Georgia FCCLA on the occasion of FCCLA's 60th anniversary; and for other  
2 purposes.

3 WHEREAS, since 1945, members of Family, Career and Community Leaders of America  
4 (FCCLA) have been addressing important personal, work, and societal issues through family  
5 and consumer science education; and

6 WHEREAS, with 17,436 members in 232 chapters across the state, Georgia FCCLA, the  
7 second largest state FCCLA association in the nation, is helping Georgia's youth to grow  
8 personally and develop the leadership skills that will serve them well throughout life; and

9 WHEREAS, in just the past ten years, Georgia FCCLA has produced two national vice  
10 presidents, three Tru-Serv national Vocational Students of the Year, three national Coca-Cola  
11 scholars, six international exchange program scholarship recipients, and a national FCCLA  
12 scholarship recipient, and its members have earned over 400 national gold medals in STAR  
13 events and have been recognized nationally by over 1,600 individual project achievement  
14 awards in the Power of One program; and

15 WHEREAS, in 2004, Georgia FCCLA members donated \$2,500.00 to Atlanta Habitat for  
16 Humanity and \$550.00 to the National Outreach Project, presented the Financial Fitness and  
17 Georgia Saves project at the National Forum to Encourage Lower Income Household  
18 Savings in Washington, D.C., and received the Youth At Its Best Award at the National  
19 Leadership Meeting in Chicago, Illinois; and

20 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia takes great pride in the achievements of these fine young  
21 men and women.

1 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body  
2 join in commending Georgia FCCLA on the grand occasion of FCCLA's 60th anniversary  
3 and extend their sincere best wishes for the continued success of this exemplary organization.
