

House Bill 17 (AS PASSED HOUSE AND SENATE)

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

1 To amend Code Section 43-38-7 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to  
2 registration by the Georgia Board of Private Detective and Security Agencies, so as to  
3 authorize the board to establish requirements of continuing education; to provide for  
4 conditions, limitations, and waiver; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 style="text-align:center">**SECTION 1.**

7 Code Section 43-38-7 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to registration by  
8 the Georgia Board of Private Detective and Security Agencies, is amended in subsection (c)  
9 by striking "and" at the end of paragraph (5), by striking the period at the end of paragraph  
10 (6) and inserting in its place "; and" and by adding a new paragraph immediately following  
11 paragraph (6), to be designated paragraph (7) to read as follows:

12 "(7) The board shall be authorized to require continuing education as a condition of  
13 renewal for all persons required to be registered with the board under this chapter. The  
14 board shall be authorized to promulgate rules and regulations addressing requirement for  
15 continuing education and circumstances for which a waiver of this requirement may be  
16 granted."
