- 1 Commending Claudette Campbell; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Caludette Campbell has been the executive director of the One Call Center of Georgia for the past 25 years; and
- 4 WHEREAS, she has served with distinction as the chairperson of the Georgia Utilities Coordinating Council; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Claudette Campbell has served with dynamic ability as the president of the American Public Works Association - Georgia Chapter; and
- 8 WHEREAS, she has served with consummate skill on the National Board of Directors and Executive Committee of the American Public Works Association; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Claudette Campbell has served with honor and dedication as cochairperson of the national "Common Ground Best Practices" Education Committee and a member of the Technical Pipeline Safety Standards Committee of the United States Department of Transportation; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Claudette Campbell is the 2004 recipient of the APWA William J. Humma award for exceptional service and is the fifth recipient in the 15 year history of the award and the first woman to receive the award; and
