7	Chapter 30 of Title 43 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to optometrists,						
8	is amended by striking subparagraph (D) of paragraph (2) of Code Section 43-30-1, relating						
9	to definitions, and inserting in lieu thereof the following:						
0	"(D) Pharmaceutical agents which are used by a doctor of optometry for treatment						
1	purposes and administered orally may only be:						
12	(i)(I) Nonnarcotic oral analgesics and Schedule III or Schedule IV controlled						
13	substances which are oral analgesics;						
4	(ii)(II) Used for ocular pain; and						
15	(iii)(III) Used for no more than 72 hours without consultation with the patient's						
16	physician-; or						
17	(ii) Oral and topical pharmaceutical agents related to the diagnosis or treatment of						
8	diseases and conditions of the eye and adnexa oculi except Schedule I or Schedule II						
9	controlled substances; provided, however, that oral steroids shall be limited to a						
20	maximum seven-day dose pack."
