

House Bill 900

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

1 To amend Part 14 of Article 6 of Chapter 2 of Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia  
2 Annotated, relating to specific programs in elementary and secondary education, so as to  
3 provide for legislative intent; to provide for the administration of funds by the Department  
4 of Education for adapted sports and physical education programs; to provide for related  
5 matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 Part 14 of Article 6 of Chapter 2 of Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,  
8 relating to specific programs in elementary and secondary education, is amended by adding  
9 a new Code Section 20-2-319 to read as follows:

10 "20-2-319.

11 It is the intent of the General Assembly that any appropriations designated for adapted  
12 sports programs for disabled students in Georgia shall be included in the budget of the  
13 Department of Education. The Department of Education shall be authorized to administer  
14 any funds received for the purpose of coordinating adapted sports and physical education  
15 programs for disabled students in Georgia. The department shall further be authorized to  
16 coordinate with organizations whose purpose is to promote, sponsor, or organize  
17 competitions and programs of adapted sports for disabled students in Georgia."

18 **SECTION 2.**

19 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
