1 Recognizing State Spelling Bee Champion James David Keane Clark; and for other
2 purposes.

3 WHEREAS, on Friday, March 25, 2005, James David Keane Clark, son of Dr. and Mrs.
4 James Clark of Waycross, Georgia, won the highly contested State Spelling Bee held at
5 Georgia State University; and

6 WHEREAS, the marathon competition lasted almost two and a half hours before James
7 David Keane Clark, correctly spelling his competitor's word, *theriatrics*, and then correctly
8 spelling his own word, *chatelet*, claimed the prestigious title; and

10 of this outstanding student who deserves much credit for his energy and dedication to
11 academic excellence; and

13 represent the State of Georgia at the Scripps National Spelling Bee to be held in Washington,
14 D.C., later this year; and

16 accomplishments of this fine young scholar.
