## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Honoring Benjamin Olin "Ben" Boyd; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Benjamin Olin "Ben" Boyd was born in Screven County, Georgia, the son of  
3 Mr. and Mrs. Olin Boyd; and
- 4 WHEREAS, he attended Screven County Schools where he played baseball, was president  
5 of the Future Farmers of America, and was a member of the 4H Club; and
- 6 WHEREAS, he graduated from Georgia Southern University with a degree in business  
7 management; and
- 8 WHEREAS, a fifth generation farmer, along with his father and his brother Will, he  
9 cultivates 3,500 acres of diversified programs of corn, cotton, peanuts, soybeans,  
10 watermelons, and small grain production; and
- 11 WHEREAS, he is a member of the Screven County Farm Bureau and the board of directors  
12 of American Farm Bureaus, and he serves as chairman of the Young Farmers Committee,

- 14 WHEREAS, he has been honored as grand marshal of the Screven County Livestock Festival  
15 Parade; and
- 16 WHEREAS, he is an active member of Jenkins Baptist Church where he serves as youth  
17 Sunday school teacher, choir member, and lay speaker; and
- 18 WHEREAS, he recently testified before the U.S. Congressional Committee that is  
19 investigating expenses to farmers created by high fuel costs.
