A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend an Act creating the Recorder's Court of Gwinnett County, approved March 27,
- 2 1972 (Ga. L. 1972, p. 3125), as amended, particularly by an Act approved April 4, 1991 (Ga.
- 3 L. 1991, p. 4183), so as to change provisions relating to the qualifications of assistant
- 4 solicitors; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 An Act creating the Recorder's Court of Gwinnett County, approved March 27, 1972 (Ga.
- 8 L. 1972, p. 3125), as amended, particularly by an Act approved April 4, 1991 (Ga. L. 1991,
- 9 p. 4183), is amended by striking in its entirety subsection (b) of Section 6A, and inserting in
- 10 lieu thereof the following:
- 11 "(b) The solicitor is authorized to employ assistant solicitors upon approval by the
- 12 governing authority of Gwinnett County. Such assistant solicitors shall perform the same
- duties as the solicitor and shall be members in good standing with the State Bar of Georgia.
- Each assistant solicitor's salary shall be in such amount as shall be provided by the
- governing authority of Gwinnett County and shall be paid by the governing authority of
- 16 Gwinnett County."

17 SECTION 2.

18 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
