A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To abolish the office of elected county surveyor of Bibb County pursuant to Code Section
2 36-7-2.1 of the O.C.G.A.; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for
3 other purposes.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 (a) Pursuant to Code Section 36-7-2.1 of the O.C.G.A., the office of elected county surveyor
7 of Bibb County is abolished.

8 (b) The Board of Commissioners of Bibb County is authorized to appoint a county surveyor.
9 The county surveyor shall be appointed for an indefinite term and shall serve at the pleasure
10 of the board of commissioners. A county surveyor appointed by the board of commissioners
11 shall possess the qualifications as provided in Code Section 36-7-2 of the O.C.G.A.
