#### A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing January 24, 2006, as "LaGrange College Day" in the State of Georgia and  
2 celebrating the 175th anniversary of LaGrange College; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, since 1831, LaGrange College has been challenging students' minds, inspiring  
4 their souls, and shaping their lives; and

5 WHEREAS, LaGrange College is a four-year liberal arts and sciences institution offering 50  
6 academic and preprofessional programs and graduate degrees in education and business; and

7 WHEREAS, LaGrange College is affiliated with the United Methodist Church and is ranked  
8 by U.S. News and World Report among the South's top comprehensive colleges and in that  
9 category's top ten best values; and

10 WHEREAS, over 1,000 students, representing 20 states and 12 countries, attend LaGrange  
11 College; and

12 WHEREAS, LaGrange College is committed to the free, uninhibited pursuit of truth, and  
13 academic freedom and free expression by faculty and students are integral to the LaGrange  
14 College ethos; and

15 WHEREAS, LaGrange College strives to be a caring and ethical community and the  
16 hallmark of the community is the quest for civility, diversity, service, and excellence.

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
18 GEORGIA that his body does hereby declare January 24, 2006, to be "LaGrange College  
19 Day" in the State of Georgia and all the citizens of Georgia are urged to take cognizance of  
20 this event and participate fittingly in the observance of its 175th anniversary.
