A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Andrew Johnson on becoming an Eagle Scout; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Andrew Johnson, a boy scout from the Alapaha Area Council, has earned the
4 rank of Eagle Scout; and

5 WHEREAS, since 1911, the Eagle has been the symbol of the highest achievement among
6 the Boy Scouts of America; and

7 WHEREAS, the attainment of Eagle Scout rank indicates that a Scout has developed
8 leadership ability, self-confidence, mature judgment, and mental and physical capabilities
9 that will be of immense benefit throughout life; and

10 WHEREAS, Andrew Johnson has amply demonstrated to his Scout leaders and peers that
11 he possesses these qualities along with sterling character; and

12 WHEREAS, for a Scout to reach Eagle rank, he must earn 21 merit badges, 12 of which are
13 mandatory requirements for the Eagle Scout program; and

14 WHEREAS, in achieving Eagle Scout status, Andrew Johnson has brought honor not only
15 to himself but also to his family and troop.

16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
17 recognize and commend Andrew Johnson for his diligence and dedication in pursuing the
18 highest honor awarded by the Boy Scouts of America and congratulate him on attaining the
19 prestigious rank of Eagle Scout.
