A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Honorable Nathan Deal, Phil Gingrey, Jack Kingston, John Linder, Charlie
2 Norwood, Tom Price, and Lynn Westmoreland with respect to H.R. 25, the Fair Tax Act;
3 and for other purposes.

4 WHEREAS, the United States Congress currently has pending before it H.R. 25, the Fair Tax
5 Act; and

6 WHEREAS, the purpose of that legislation is to repeal all corporate and individual income
7 taxes, payroll taxes, self-employment taxes, capital gains taxes, estate taxes, and gift taxes
8 and replace them with a revenue-neutral personal consumption tax; and

9 WHEREAS, the Fair Tax offers long needed tax relief in the form of lower prices, nearly
10 nonexistent compliance costs, and the ability to choose how much to spend in taxes to all
11 Americans, while eliminating the income tax and allowing Americans to keep 100 percent
12 of their paychecks; and

13 WHEREAS, this much needed proposal will dramatically reduce prices, protect and ensure
14 funding of Social Security and medicare, empower low-income earners, and put choice and
15 control back into the hands of every American.

16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
17 Honorable Nathan Deal, Phil Gingrey, Jack Kingston, John Linder, Charlie Norwood, Tom
18 Price, and Lynn Westmoreland are commended for sponsoring H.R. 25, the Fair Tax Act.
