A RESOLUTION

- 1 Remembering and honoring the life of Mr. Nelson Greene; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Mr. Nelson Greene, 64, a beloved community leader, departed this life on
3 January 7, 2006; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Mr. Greene, born in Manor, Georgia, served his country honorably as a member
5 of the United States Navy and was a career employee of CSX Railroad; and
- 6 WHEREAS, a devoted public servant, Mr. Greene served three terms on the Ware County
7 Commission, holding the positions of vice chairman and chairman pro tempore and leading
8 to his service as board secretary of the Southeast Georgia Regional and Development
9 Commission; and
- 10 WHEREAS, in addition to his numerous civic roles, including his membership in the
11 Waycross-Ware County Chamber of Commerce's "Sales Team," Mr. Greene was a Boy
12 Scout and Cub Scout master for 15 years, as well as a very active and faithful member of the
13 Macedonia Baptist Church; and
- 14 WHEREAS, so widely respected was he that the Nelson Greene Senior Citizens Center is
15 named in his honor; and
- 16 WHEREAS, Mr. Greene was a devoted family man and is survived by his wife, Mrs. Eala
17 Lovings Greene, and three daughters; and
- 18 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia lost a most estimable citizen on January 7, 2006, with the
19 passing of Mr. Nelson Greene.

1 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
2 the members of this body join together to express their deepest regret at the passing of Mr.
3 Nelson Greene and extend their most sincere condolences to his family.
