A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Article 1 of Chapter 18 of Title 45 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 2 relating to the state employees' health insurance plan, so as to provide time requirements for
- 3 the credentialing of hospitals, physicians, and other health care providers by a new
- 4 third-party administrator of the state employees' health insurance plan; to provide for related
- 5 matters; to provide for applicability; to provide for an effective date; to repeal conflicting
- 6 laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 SECTION 1.

- 9 Article 1 of Chapter 18 of Title 45 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the
- state employees' health insurance plan, is amended by adding a new Code section to the end
- 11 of such article to read as follows:
- *"*45-18-20.

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- 13 At any time in which the board selects and enters into a contract with a new third party to
- administer health benefits under this article, the new third-party administrator shall be
- required to complete the credentialing process on any hospital, physician, or other health
- 16 care provider:
- 17 (1) Within seven days of entering into a contract with the board to reapprove any
- hospital, physician, or other health care provider that had been approved and credentialed
- by the third-party administrator immediately preceding the new third-party administrator;
- 20 and
- 21 (2) Within 30 days of entering into a contract with the board to approve any hospital,
- 22 physician, or other health care provider that is to be newly approved and credentialed by
- 23 the third-party administrator.
- 24 The board shall have the authority to grant, in its sole discretion, up to 21 additional days
- 25 to the third-party administrator with respect to paragraphs (1) and (2) of this Code section
- 26 if the administrator can demonstrate due diligence in its efforts to meet such time

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1 requirements. The requirements of this Code section shall be included in the contract

2 entered into between the board and the third-party administrator."

3 SECTION 2.

- 4 This Act shall apply to all plan years beginning on and after January 1, 2007.
- 5 SECTION 3.
- 6 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law
- 7 without such approval.
- 8 SECTION 4.
- 9 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
