A RESOLUTION

1 Declaring District 44 Days at the Capitol on January 24 and January 31, 2006; and for other
2 purposes.

3 WHEREAS, on January 24 and January 31, 2006, elected officials from the state, county,
4 and municipal levels, along with the constituents they serve, will come together to declare
5 and celebrate the success and unique appeal of District 44 of the Georgia House of
6 Representatives; and

7 WHEREAS, District 44 comprises a vibrant, beautiful community, rich in natural resources
8 and competitive business; and

9 WHEREAS, encompassing areas of Cobb and Fulton counties, House District 44 is a diverse
10 part of the greater Atlanta metropolitan area; and

11 WHEREAS, going from north to south, the district stretches from Cumberland Mall at I-285
12 and U.S. Highway 41 to Collier Heights south of I-20; although the shape has changed over
13 the years, historically, District 44 has been divided into two parts by the Chattahoochee
14 River, with the northern area being in Cobb County and the southern part in Fulton County
15 and the City of Atlanta; and

16 WHEREAS, an exciting area and a wonderful place to live and work, District 44 is an
17 integral part of the great State of Georgia; and

18 WHEREAS, the 2006 District 44 Days at the Capitol are dedicated to the purpose of
19 recognizing and celebrating the vibrancy of the people of that district, their diversity, and
20 commitment.

21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
22 the members of this body recognize and observe District 44 Days at the Capitol on January

1 24 and 31, 2006, and heartily welcome to the Capitol the elected public officials and
