- 1 Congratulating the Court of Appeals of Georgia on the occasion of its 100th anniversary; and
- 2 for other purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, on October 6, 1906, voters ratified a constitutional amendment creating the
- 4 Court of Appeals of Georgia, and its three judges held the court's first session in what is now
- 5 the Appropriations Room of the State Capitol on January 7, 1907; and
- 6 WHEREAS, formed as a means of relieving the Supreme Court of Georgia of its overflowing
- 7 caseload, the Court of Appeals of Georgia has become an integral part of our state's judicial
- 8 system; and
- 9 WHEREAS, the caseload of the Court of Appeals of Georgia has increased significantly
- alongside the growth of Georgia's population and economy; and
- 11 WHEREAS, throughout its history, the Court of Appeals of Georgia has been committed to
- 12 ensuring fairness and faithfulness to our laws; and
- 13 WHEREAS, in 2006, the Court of Appeals of Georgia will be celebrating its Centennial, and
- 14 it invites all Georgians to mark this anniversary year by examining the rich history of this
- 15 distinguished institution of justice.
- 16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
- 17 the members of this body join together in congratulating the Court of Appeals of Georgia on
- 18 the occasion of its 100th anniversary and designate 2006 as a year honoring the Court of
- 19 Appeals as an important component of state government.
- 20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
- 21 and directed to transmit an appropriate copy of this resolution to Chief Judge John H. Ruffin,
