## A RESOLUTION

1 Relative to adjournment; and for other purposes.

2 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA that, unless otherwise  
 3 provided by subsequent resolution of the General Assembly, the meeting dates and dates of  
 4 adjournment for the 2006 regular session of the General Assembly for the period of  
 5 January 23, 2006, through February 6, 2006, shall be as follows:

9	Thursday, January 26	.....	in session for legislative day 9

13	Monday, January 30	.....	in adjournment
14	Tuesday, January 31	.....	in session for legislative day 10
15	Wednesday, February 1	.....	in session for legislative day 11

17	Friday, February 3	.....	in session for legislative day 13
18	Saturday, February 4	.....	in adjournment
19	Sunday, February 5	.....	in adjournment
20	Monday, February 6	.....	in session for legislative day 14

21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that on and after February 6, 2006, the periods of  
 22 adjournment of the 2006 session, if any, shall be as specified by subsequent resolution of the  
 23 General Assembly, except that for the remainder of the 2006 regular session, unless  
 24 otherwise provided by subsequent resolution, the General Assembly shall adjourn at the close  
 25 of the legislative day on each Friday on which the General Assembly is in session and shall  
 26 reconvene on the following Monday.

1 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that, as authorized by Code Section 28-1-2, the hours for  
2 closing and convening the Senate on each day may be as ordered by the Senate; and the  
3 hours for closing and convening the House on each day may be as ordered by the House.
