

House Bill 1109

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

1 To amend Code Section 44-12-300 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to  
2 tribes, bands, groups, or communities recognized by the state as legitimate American Indian  
3 Tribes, so as to change the address of one such tribe; to provide an effective date; to repeal  
4 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 **SECTION 1.**

7 Code Section 44-12-300 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to tribes, bands,  
8 groups, or communities recognized by the state as legitimate American Indian Tribes, is  
9 amended by striking subsection (a) and inserting in its place the following:

10 "(a) The State of Georgia officially recognizes as legitimate American Indian tribes of  
11 Georgia the following tribes, bands, groups, or communities:

12 (1) The Georgia Tribe of Eastern Cherokee

14 ~~Dahlonega, Georgia 30533~~

15 Address as registered with the Secretary of State's office;

16 (2) The Lower Muscogee Creek Tribe

17 Route 2, Box 370

18 Whigham, Georgia 31797; and

19 (3) The Cherokee of Georgia Tribal Council

20 Saint George, Georgia 31646."

21 **SECTION 2.**

22 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law  
23 without such approval.
