A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 48-8-3 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 exemptions from sales and use taxes, so as to provide for a partial exemption with respect
- 3 to the sale or use of natural or artificial gas, No. 2 fuel oil, No. 6 fuel oil, propane, coal, and
- 4 the fuel cost recovery component of retail electric rates; to repeal conflicting laws; and for
- 5 other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 Code Section 48-8-3 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to exemptions from
- 9 sales and use taxes, is amended by adding a new paragraph immediately following paragraph
- 10 (70) to be designated paragraph (70.1), to read as follows:
- 11 "(70.1)(A) The sale of natural or artificial gas, No. 2 fuel oil, No. 6 fuel oil, propane,
- coal, and the fuel cost recovery component of retail electric rates.
- 13 (B) The exemption provided for in subparagraph (A) of this paragraph shall not apply
- to the first \$5.49 per decatherm of the sales price or cost price of natural or artificial
- gas, the first \$1.08 per gallon of the sales price or cost price of No. 2 fuel oil, the first
- \$0.63 per gallon of the sales price or cost price of No. 6 fuel oil, the first \$0.74 per
- gallon of the sales price or cost price of propane, the first \$39.41 per ton of coal, or the
- first 1.6323¢ per kilowatt hour of the fuel cost recovery component of retail electricity
- rates whether such fuel recovery charges are charged separately or are embedded in
- such electric rates."

- 22 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
