1 Senator Zamarripa of the 36th offered the following amendment:

2 *Amend the Senate amendment to the House substitute to SB 84 by inserting after "electors"*
 3 *on line 4 on page 1 "; to require the Department of Driver Services to establish a program*
 4 *utilizing mobile identification card issuance units with which nursing homes and high rise*
 5 *apartment and assisted living facilities can schedule on site opportunities for residents of*
 6 *such facilities to obtain identification cards" and by inserting after line 8 on page 1 the*
 7 *following:*

8 By redesignating Sections 4 and 5 as Sections 5 and 6, respectively, and inserting after line
 9 32 on page 5 the following:

SECTION 4.

10 Said title is further amended by adding a new Code Section 40-5-106 to read as follows:

11 "40-5-106.

12 (a) The department shall establish a program utilizing mobile identification card issuance
 13 units which nursing homes and high rise apartment and assisted living facilities may
 14 request to come to such nursing homes and high rise apartment and assisted living facilities
 15 upon reasonable notice and at reasonable times to provide the residents thereof the
 16 opportunity to obtain identification cards pursuant to this article.

17 (b) The program shall include the provision of a toll-free number that citizens of this state
 18 may call to schedule a visit by a mobile identification card issuance unit to a nursing home
 19 or high rise apartment or assisted living facility.

20 (c) The mobile units shall be in good repair and shall have regularly scheduled
 21 maintenance performed on them. Should a mobile unit break down or be rendered
 22 unusable, such mobile unit shall be replaced in a timely manner. The department shall
 23 promulgate rules and regulations to ensure that the mobile units are well maintained and
 24 shall also place age and mileage limitations on such units to ensure reliability.

25 (d) The mobile units shall be capable of producing identification cards for persons with
 26 physical disabilities on site.

27 (e) The number of mobile units provided shall be related to the demand in the communities
 28 for such services."
