## A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring the life and memory of Randy Stephen Vanek; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Mr. Randy Stephen Vanek was a lifelong resident and distinguished citizen of  
3 Dallas, Georgia, who was born on August 10, 1948, and passed away on January 1, 2006;

5 WHEREAS, he was the son of the late Carl and Alma Shelton Vanek, attended public  
6 schools in his hometown, and graduated from Dallas High School in 1966; and

7 WHEREAS, he served his country with honor and distinction in the United States Army,  
8 serving two tours of duty in Vietnam in the 5th Infantry of the 1st Brigade and being awarded  
9 a Purple Heart after his first tour of duty; and

11 business and went on to become a supervisor for the Paulding County Community  
12 Development Department where he compiled an exemplary record of public service to his  
13 community; and

14 WHEREAS, Mr. Vanek's survivors include his loving wife of 36 years, Susan Osborne  
15 Vanek; his two children, Scott Vanek of Dallas and Jamie Alsobrook of Hiram; and three  
16 granddaughters; and

17 WHEREAS, all who were privileged to know this distinguished Georgian join his family in  
18 mourning his loss.
