## A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Charles R. Ford on becoming an Eagle Scout; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Charles R. Ford of Boy Scout Troop 554 of Lawrenceville, Georgia, has earned  
3 the rank of Eagle Scout after completing the rigorous requirements of this honor, including  
4 overseeing the construction of a 30 foot long bridge at Fort Yargo State Park for his Eagle  
5 Scout project; and

6 WHEREAS, Charles R. Ford will receive this highest achievement among Boy Scouts of  
7 America in an Eagle Scout Court of Honor on January 28, 2006; and

8 WHEREAS, the attainment of Eagle Scout rank indicates that a Scout has developed  
9 leadership ability, self-confidence, mature judgment, and mental and physical capabilities  
10 that will be of immense benefit throughout life; and

12 possesses these qualities along with sterling character; and

13 WHEREAS, for a Scout to reach Eagle rank, he must earn 21 merit badges, 12 of which are  
14 mandatory requirements for the Eagle Scout program; and

15 WHEREAS, in achieving Eagle Scout status, Charles R. Ford has brought honor not only to  
16 himself but also to his family and troop.

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
18 the members of this body recognize and commend Charles R. Ford for his diligence and  
19 dedication in pursuing the highest honor awarded by the Boy Scouts of America and  
20 congratulate him on attaining the prestigious rank of Eagle Scout.
