## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Commending Scott Alan Richardson; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Scott Alan Richardson of Troop 94, Woodstock, Georgia, has attained the rank  
3 of Eagle Scout, the most distinguished rank conferred by the Boy Scouts of America; and
- 4 WHEREAS, a candidate for the most exceptional award in scouting must complete a  
5 rigorous program of training and demonstrate his proficiency in selected scouting techniques  
6 and attainment of the highest ideals of scouting; and
- 7 WHEREAS, only one scout out of 97 ever reaches this lofty level of achievement, and Scott  
8 Alan Richardson has ably demonstrated his aptitude and competency in mastering the various  
9 special skills taught through the Boy Scout program; and
- 10 WHEREAS, this outstanding young man has truly exhibited a commitment to the scouting  
11 principles of honesty and fairness and has consistently conducted himself in a manner  
12 becoming an Eagle Scout; and
- 13 WHEREAS, in a world which consistently seems to accentuate the negative aspects of the  
14 actions of young people, it is abundantly fitting and proper for this body to recognize with  
15 particularity the outstanding accomplishments of this extraordinary individual.

17 commend Scott Alan Richardson for his diligence and dedication in pursuing the highest  
18 honor awarded by the Boy Scouts of America and congratulate him on attaining the
