

Senate Bill 475

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

1 To amend Chapter 25 of Title 33 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to life  
2 insurance, so as to provide that no insurer offering life insurance coverage to citizens of this  
3 state shall deny or refuse to accept an application for life insurance; refuse to issue or renew  
4 a contract of life insurance; cancel, restrict, or otherwise terminate a contract of life  
5 insurance; or charge a different rate for the same life insurance coverage, based upon an  
6 applicant's or insured's past or future travel to the State of Israel; to provide for certain  
7 exceptions; to provide for related matters; to provide an effective date; to repeal conflicting  
8 laws; and for other purposes.

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

10 SECTION 1.

11 Chapter 25 of Title 33 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to life insurance,  
12 is amended by adding a new Code Section 33-25-14 to read as follows:

13 "33-25-14.

14 On and after July 1, 2006, no insurer offering life insurance coverage to citizens of this  
15 state shall deny or refuse to accept an application for life insurance; refuse to issue or  
16 renew a contract of life insurance; cancel, restrict, or otherwise terminate a contract of life  
17 insurance; or charge a different rate for the same life insurance coverage, based upon an  
18 applicant's or insured's past or future travel to the State of Israel."

19 SECTION 2.

20 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law  
21 without such approval.

22 SECTION 3.

23 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
