A RESOLUTION

- 1 Urging the House of Representatives to recite the pledge of allegiance to the Georgia flag at
- 2 appropriate times; and for other purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, Georgia law has included a pledge of allegiance to the Georgia flag since 1951;
- 4 and
- 5 WHEREAS, Official Code of Georgia Annotated Section 50-3-2 provides that the pledge of
- 6 allegiance to the state flag is: "I pledge allegiance to the Georgia flag and to the principles
- 7 for which it stands: Wisdom, Justice, and Moderation"; and
- 8 WHEREAS, the words of the pledge of allegiance to the Georgia flag appropriately
- 9 encompass the words "Wisdom, Justice, and Moderation," which have appeared on the Great
- 10 Seal of Georgia for more than 90 years; and
- 11 WHEREAS, the existence and words of the pledge of allegiance to the Georgia flag are not
- 12 well known among Representatives or other Georgians; and
- 13 WHEREAS, it is altogether fitting and proper for the House of Representatives to recite the
- 14 pledge to the Georgia flag.
- 15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
- 16 the members of this body are urged to adopt a custom of reciting the pledge to the Georgia
- 17 flag in unison at appropriate times, including but not limited to the first and last days of the
- 18 General Assembly session, near the beginning of the House proceedings on such days.
